Her passions are reading, writing, traveling with her family, walking in the woods and dancing flamenco.

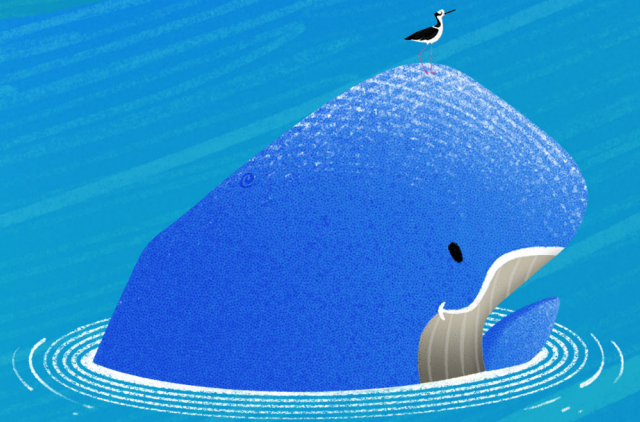
She works in a community garden once a week and when she has time, she goes swimming in the rivers and lakes where she lives.
